Overview:

The test will consist of multiple choice, true/false and short answer questions and will cover ONLY section 1 (Intro to Class) Section 2 (Intro to Planning). All of the questions will come directly from the Handouts. Thus, if you study the class handouts and know ALL of the short answer questions you should be fine.

Possible Short Answer Questions: 5 of the following will be on the Exam

1. Define what the “Built Environment” is and provide examples of major aspects of the built environment
2. Discuss how the built environment is important to crime prevention efforts.
3. Discuss the three main “costs” of crime. Be able to define and explain a little about all three aspects.
4. Define what Infill Development is and why it is important from a crime prevention perspective.
5. Define what mixed use development is and why it is important from a crime prevention perspective.
6. Discuss the research on crime patterns related to one of the following major planning issues: Vacant properties; Land Use; Transit related crime; Alleys; Parking or Permeability.
7. Define urban planning and discuss what its main purpose is within local government.
8. Discuss the three main areas of urban planning and how they differ.
9. Provide 3 of the main goals of planning and define them completely.
10. Discuss the three main TOOLS used by planners and how they differ from each other.
 - a. KNOW EACH OF THESE AREAS WELL FOR THE M/C AND T/F QUESTIONS
11. Compare and contrast the Planning commission and the Board of Adjustments.
12. Discuss the main duties of a town planner.
13. Discuss some of the major things that need to be considered when creating a comprehensive plan.
